SCOTT CLEVELAND ANNOUNCES BID FOR 2nd Congressional District Water, Immigration, and Economy Key Issues

(Eagle, Idaho) February 5, 2024--Scott Cleveland, a successful businessman and Garden City resident, has announced today his bid to run for the 2nd Congressional District (CD) of Idaho.

Cleveland said water rights and the breaching of the four lower Snake River dams will be the focus of his meetings with voters in the 2nd CD that stretches from Eastern Idaho to the Treasure Valley. He added that the economy and the invasion of illegal aliens round out the top three issues of most concern to Idaho voters.

“Breaching the four lower Snake River dams would have a devastating effect on the economy and the citizens of the 2nd CD, a position the current office holder supports and promotes. Cleveland just completed a short two-day swing through Eastern Idaho and will be travelling the district extensively between now and primary election day, May 21st.

Cleveland is attending Lincoln Day events and scheduling other meetings throughout the district to fully inform voters about his platform, based on his experiences as a successful businessman and a conservative leader in the GOP and other groups.
